

Bowls Director's Report for May 2021

Minutes of our Bowls Management Committee of 12th May have been presented.

May 31 is the final vote day for Joint Unification for Women's Bowls NSW and Bowls NSW. I have available for presentation a Members' Information and Voting Pack, Headed "Securing Our Future: Bowls in NSW Unification".

On the 28th May the Zone Pennants playoffs will be held at Pottsville and Cabaritta. We will have teams in both Division 7 and 2 Playing. If they win through they will then go to State Play offs. We have a team competing in the open Zone State pairs at Evans Head on the 5th June.

On the Queen's Birthday Monday 14th Monday bowls will be a Norfolk Bowlers sponsored day of triples with approximately 60 players competing. We are hoping to use the mobile bar at this event. During June we will have the Club Open Singles being played.

Night Bowls Tuesday and Breakie Bowls once a month is continuing.

It is hoped that we might be able to install the new shades on the top green prior to the Great Northern Classic. How we are able to do this is up for discussion.

Last week we advertised for entries to our Great Northern Classic Fours to be held on the 23rd and 24th October. By the end of the week 28 teams had been submitted. Players coming are of the highest level in Australian Bowling. There are also a number of reserve teams. This will see 112 bowlers competing over the two days of competition.

The Bowls Management Committee is also to present \$400.00 to assist four bowlers from Ocean Shores representing Zone 1 in the Inter Zone finals held in Tamworth next month.

Pennants continue with good results for Ocean Shores. Three teams have good prospect of making the Zone Finals. Neil McLeod and Troy Makin are to compete in the Zone pair's final in June.
